AmCham Charitable Foundation is proud to announce the annual Lyn Edinger U.S. Studies Scholarship. The Scholarship is available to a qualified graduate of a secondary school in Hong Kong to pursue studies at a U.S. university.

**The Award:** One (1) one-time scholarship award of HK\$24,000 for a secondary school graduate from Hong Kong to pursue undergraduate study at a U.S. college or university.

# Eligibility Requirements - Students must fulfill ALL of the following criteria to apply:

- 1. Hold permanent residency in Hong Kong.
- 2. Have received six years of continuous education in a secondary school in Hong Kong.
- 3. Be enrolled now as a full-time student in Secondary 6 of a Hong Kong school for the year 2022-2023.
- 4. Have successfully gained admission to an undergraduate degree program at a U.S. four-year college or university as a first-year student in the fall of 2023.
