

## KGV Student Dress Code

The KGV Dress Code is a product of feedback and collaboration from students, parents and staff and has been endorsed by the KGV PTSA. KGV School has a dress code to support:

- The ease of identification and the safety of our students in the school and community.
  - Our inclusivity, equity and our social justice priorities. Having a school uniform affords all students the opportunity to present well, especially considering the range of socio-economic circumstances within our community.
  - A positive school appearance at school and in our community, where our students are in regular contact with prospective employers, tertiary education institutions, future parents and students, and members of the general public.
  - A culture of high expectations for personal presentation
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### All Students Must Wear:

- Navy Blue (Years 7-11) or Khaki (Years 12-13) skort/shorts/trousers with the KGV/ESF logo purchased from our online uniform provider. As a guide, the minimum length of the shorts and skort is defined as 10cm from the top of the knee to the hem when the student is standing.
- White long or short sleeve shirt with a school badge
- White KGV logo socks with skorts and shorts and black KGV logo socks or plain navy blue socks are worn with trousers.
- Black leather belt if wearing trousers or shorts

### Optional items

- Navy blue V-neck pullover or fleece with school/ESF badge
- Navy blue blazer with school badge

### Shoes

- Shoes must be black polishable leather.
- The upper must fully enclose the foot.
- Boots, canvas, 'Mary Jane' and 'ballet' styles are not permitted.
- There should be no rubberised toe to the shoe and the shoes must be completely black (no other colours on the shoe).

### Winter Uniform (Week after Challenge week until Easter vacation starts)

- School Tie (worn in months of November to Easter)
- Plain Navy or black scarves Plain Navy or black tights

## PE Uniform

- ESF Branded PE shorts
- KGV branded coloured House Shirt with school badge
- Sports shoes (any colour permitted)

## Optional items and further information

- Swimming Goggles
- KGV House Swimming Cap
- One-piece swimmers or swim trunks or PE shorts or Board shorts
- Plain Black or white rash shirt
- Students can wear leggings/track pants during PE lessons. If they choose to wear leggings/track pants, students change at the beginning and end of the lesson. Leggings should be plain black
- KGV white socks
- School sports shirts must be worn over the top of any training under layers
- If students wish to wear flip flops during the swimming program, they can only wear them between the change rooms and pool deck.

## Drama Uniform

- Black shorts with school/ESF badge (also used for PE)
- Black drama shirt with school badge

## Optional items and further information

- Students can wear leggings/track pants during Drama lessons. If they choose to wear leggings/track pants, students change at the beginning and end of the lesson. The leggings should be plain black.



## Make-up and nails

- Discrete makeup permitted, such as a light foundation
- Nails must be a length to enable participation in sports and other activities
- No acrylic or stick-on nails permitted

## Hair

- Clean and generally neat and tidy.
- Colouring of hair allowed, using predominantly natural tonings
- Extreme hairstyles (e.g. mohawks, shaved sections, bright, unnatural hair colours) are not permitted).

## Accessories

- Necklaces may be worn as small medallions under the shirt and not visible
- Earrings can be worn. They must be either studs or small hoops with a maximum diameter of 10mm
- Bars, spacers, spikes or other ornaments are not allowed. If facial piercings are worn, they must be clear.
- Except for a watch, no other jewellery is permitted (e.g. bracelets, rings and anklets)

## Undergarments

- Undershirts and undergarments should not be visible through uniform (e.g. no bright colours or inappropriate or offensive text or images, etc.)
